

# Unlinked Liverpool Doodsons

Doodson yet to be linked to the main Liverpool trees

## Family trees prepared by Mike Doodson

Sources of information: Census returns for 1841-1911 plus Births Marriages and Deaths records, including Parish records  
Additional information from Naval Casualties records

Entries in **bold** type - given (Christian) names  
Entries in *italic* type - spouse surnames



Thomas - widower  
1841 census: Thomas, Elizabeth, Alice (recorded as Threlfall) and Margaret Dudson (b. 1786) at Worth Street, Liverpool  
1851 census (at Stanley Street) gives Elizabeth's birth year as 1787, whereas 1841 gives it as 1801

Could Elizabeth be a the Elizabeth b.1799 to William at the head of the main Toxteth Park tree, from his first marriage?

**Thomas** Threlfall (1797 - ?) Preston  
m. 1835 St Martin in the field, Liverpool  
**Elizabeth** Doodson (1787 - ?) ?

**Louisa** Doodson (1822 - 27) Liverpool  
**Alice** Doodson/Threlfall (1831 - ?) Liverpool  
**Margaret** Doodson (1831 - 32) Liverpool  
**Margaret** (1835 - 37) Liverpool  
**Martha** (1842 - 42) Liverpool  
**Jane** (1844 - 44) Liverpool

Louisa, Alice and Margaret all illegitimate daughters of Elizabeth (recorded as "spinster")  
All had abode Dennison Street  
Louisa and Margaret baptised St Paul, Alice baptised St Martin in the field

Margaret buried St Paul, Liverpool  
Abode: Denison Street

Margaret, Martha and Jane - not proved to be Thomas and Elizabeth's children, but abode and location of burial makes it likely they are.

Margaret abode at death Dennison Street  
Buried St Pauls

Margaret abode at death Charter Street  
Buried at St Martin in the Fields, Liverpool

Jane abode at death Greenwood Street  
Buried at St Martin in the Fields, Liverpool

**James Jackson** (1797 - ?) Liverpool  
m. 1830 St Mary, Edge Hill, Liverpool  
**Catherine Doodson** (1796 - ?)

Thomas may be son of Thomas Doodson and Catherine Weigh

One member tree on Ancestry has Thomas Doodson (who married Emma Stretch) as son of Thomas and Catherine Weigh (see main tree)  
Baptism records that spelled the surname Dodson indicate Thomas was indeed their child, baptised 1814 at St Peter, Liverpool, Abode George Street

Thomas is likely related to Catherine Doodson (above) who married James Jackson in 1830 (transcribed as Dudson)

Emma's parents - Thomas and Margaret Stretch.  
Emma left her estate to Charles and Catherine Linaker Living at Frodsham at death

Marriage of Thomas and Emma confirmed through tying up page references in Oct-Dec 1858 marriage records

**Thomas** (1814/19 - 83) b.Liverpool d.Aston-by-Sutton  
m. 1858 Runcorn  
**Emma Stretch** (1820 - 1900) b.Keckwick/Daresbury, Cheshire d.Frodsham

No indication of any children

**1841 census:** Thomas (butcher) living with James (butcher) and Catherine Jackson at Park Lane, Liverpool.  
**Doodson** transcribed as "Woodson"  
**1851 census:** Thomas (cattle dealer) visiting Thomas and Elizabeth Henderson, 82 Rupert Street, Liverpool.  
**1861 census:** Thomas and Emma at Sutton  
**1871 census:** (recorded as Dudson) Thomas (farmer) and Emma at Chester Road, Sutton (Runcorn), with nieces Emma Jackson and William LInaker  
**1881 census:** Thomas and Emma at same address Sutton  
**1891 census:** Emma in Frodsham

## Miscellaneous Doodsons unlinked elsewhere

**Edward** (1805 - ?) Liverpool

**Ellen** (1808 - 11) Liverpool

Ellen, "daughter of William and Elizabeth Doodson" buried, aged 3 years 1811, St Anne, Liverpool  
Could not trace different William and Elizabeth as potential parents. Could not trace record of birth either.

**Mary Jane** (1821 - ?) Liverpool

**Maria** (1837 - 39) Liverpool

Maria abode at death Brook Street, Toxteth Park  
Buried St Anne, Liverpool

**George** (? - ?) ?

**Harriet** (1843 - 45) Liverpool

**Henry** (1845 - 49) Liverpool

Henry abode at death Windsor Street, Toxteth Park  
Buried at St Anne, Liverpool

**Lillian** (1878 - 80) Liverpool
