A tree tracing Doodsons in Oldham on the 1911 census

Unlinked and fragmented
Although there are a few distinct family groups on these trees these are unlinked to other major trees - no provable links have been found ... yet.

No definitive trace prior to 1911
1911: boarding at 10 Dalton Street, Chadderton

No definitive trace prior to 1891
1891: lodging at Beeson Brickworks, Oldham. - Blacksmith. Recorded as born in Bury.
1901: boarding at "Model" Castle Street, Oldham. - carter. Recorded as born in Bury
1911: at Jagers Working Mens Home, Beaver Street. - Blacksmith striker. Described as being single

James is described as a bleacher on the marriage records of Thomas and Betty and Thomas and Mary

Fanny had been living in Rooden Lane, Prestwich when she died. Given that Thomas lived there at least between 1853 and his death in 1859, she might have been related to Thomas

One Thomas Doodson was baptised at St Thomas, Pendleton in 1807 to James (crofter) and Ann Doodson

Thomas' occupation described as Barm Seller in his marriage records and that of Joseph and Ann below. During this period Thomas lived at Rooden Lane, a hamlet near Prestwich

1871: Joseph (described as a printer) and Ann living in Thornsett, next door to Ann's parents and family
Joseph died in 1877 in an asylum in Derbyshire. Ann remarried in 1878 to John Howe
1881: Harry as step-son of John and Ann Howe at Thornset, New Mills. Recorded as born in Thornset, Derbyshire. Living next door was Mary Doodson, granddaughter of William Liddiard.
1891: Harry and Mary living with Howe family at Thornsett. Both described as step-children of John Howe and Ann (now remarried to John)

1871: Thomas and Mary living at Clayton Street, Prestwich
1871: Mary (widow) at Clayton Street, Prestwich
1891: Mary (widow) at Park Terrace, Prestwich

1901: no trace of Harry
1911: Harry and family at 43 Wood End, Shaw
1939: Harry and Lily at Duckworth Street, Crompton

1911: Mary servant at home of Proctor in Riston (near Blackburn)

1939: Fred in Devizes, Wiltshire. Did not marry

Florrie married Frank Clarke in 1936 In Middleton
