

1900 census: Peter was deaf, and attended the Pennsylvania School for the Deaf in Mt Airy, Penn. DOB recorded incorrectly as 1895 1909 marriage - shows his birth date as 28/1/1884, Wilkes-Barre 1918 (Sept 1918) WW1 Draft Card lists Mary as wife and home as in Philadelphia, though Peter was listed in the LA city directory in 1914 **1920 census:** Peter boarding in Philadelphia, Penn. Parents shown as born in England. Occupation - "box master" in factory

LA voter lists and city directories: Peter J Doodson on voter list in LA, CA, 1930 census: Mary in Norwalk State Hospital for the Insane, Los Angeles **1940 Census**: Mary in Patton State Hospital for the Insane, Highland, San Bernardino, California 1940 voter list: "Miss Mary Doodson" on voter list in 1940 (and also on war service registration card in 1940, at same address as Peter)

1940 Census: George and family lodging at 102 Richmond Street, Boston, Mass. Same address in 1935. George clerical for bridge and roads project.




