

Sporting Australian Doodsons: Cycling: Robert (b.1890) and George (b.1889) Doodson were active in cycling races in Sydney area in 1920s: Robert was active 1908-15 and 1921-26. He joined the Peerless Bicycle Club in March 1910, took part in a 24 hour event in Dec 1913 and won the Sydney League annual 10 mile race in 1913 George was also active in cycling between 1913-15 and 1921-1925 Football: Walter Victor Doodson (b.1893) played in goal for Pyrmont against Canterbury in the 1919 Kerr Challenge Cup ("British Association Game" - i.e. soccer)
